DIRECTIONS to REDLINE Rennsport – Take Route 17 (86) to the Greater Binghamton area. From Route 17 (86), take exit 67S - Vestal to State Route 26S. My shop is approximately 3 miles on the right. First blinking light at Hazel Drive. Second at top of large hill – Pierce Hill Rd. 3rd blinking light, SLOW DOWN. My shop is just past this intersection on the right. VanDervort Service Center (1694 Route 26, Vestal, NY.)(White building on right, 3 bay wash, 3 bay repair, used cars, etc). My shop is in the North end of the adjacent tan building. Brown pedestrian door and overhead doors. No sign, no windows, no phone. Only cool cars and motorheads!
